

Pembina Hills Book Award:

Or...How to Get Grade Nines to Actually Read a Book,
Amidst a World Filled with Digital Distractions



Context

- ❑ We are classroom teachers
 - ❑ AISI--16 years ago! (*Thanks, Judy...*)
 - ❑ Continued collaboration

Project Background

- ❑ Observations:
 - ❑ Fewer students read for pleasure
 - ❑ The literacy skills of our students are declining
 - ❑ Stamina is diminishing
 - ❑ Students in high school struggle to meet the demands

Our Guiding Beliefs

- ❑ Reading is important
- ❑ Given the following conditions, grade nines will read:
 - ❑ Quality books
 - ❑ Limited choice (too much choice is intimidating)
 - ❑ Time in class to read
 - ❑ Opportunities to share
 - ❑ A supportive and enthusiastic environment

Process: Before

- ❑ Before:
 - ❑ Preparations and invitations
 - ❑ 5 schools
 - ❑ 10 teachers
 - ❑ 13 diverse grade 9 classes
 - ❑ 239 students

Process: During

- ❑ During:
 - ❑ Baseline measures
 - ❑ Survey
 - ❑ Written component
 - ❑ Introducing the books
 - ❑ Expectations
 - ❑ 5 books, 1 novel, 75-90 minutes/week

Process: After

- ❑ After:
 - ❑ Post-project measures
 - ❑ Survey
 - ❑ Business letter
 - ❑ Teacher meeting
 - ❑ Adjustments for next year
 - ❑ Add more genres--horror/humour/fantasy
 - ❑ Start earlier

Initial Impressions from Data

- ❑ Initially
 - ❑ Many students saw themselves as nonreaders
 - ❑ 38% do not want to read, ever
 - ❑ 8% had not read one book (Sept.-Dec.)
 - ❑ 60% had read 1-5 books (Sept.-Dec.)
 - ❑ 30% are lapsed readers

Impressions from Post-Project Data

- ❑ The majority of students complied with the 5 books, one novel requirement
- ❑ 91% of students say the project should continue
- ❑ Every student found at least one book that they enjoyed
- ❑ Many students expressed appreciation for being able to participate in the project

Moving Forward: Next Year

- ❑ Keep the most read titles
- ❑ Add a limited number of titles - mostly novels
- ❑ All participating teachers have been invited to help choose additional books
 - ❑ Books have been purchased and provided

Final Project Costs

2017-18

- ❑ Approx. \$500/class
- ❑ TOTAL: \$6000

2018-19

- ❑ Approx. \$200/class
- ❑ Additional classes?
- ❑ TOTAL: \$2500
